Governor Smt. Baby Rani Maurya presented the Governor Award-2018 for best researcher at Rajbhawan on Thursday. This year, first, second and third prizes were awarded in the research work of science and technology. Dr. Anuj Nehra of UTU was awarded first prize for developing rapid H.I.V. serum testing kit based on Graphene Oxide Polycarbonate Track. The research work of Dr Anuj also got indo-US patent. Dr. Anil Kumar of G B Pant Agriculture and Technology University got the second prize for the research work in the Alternaria Blight Disease in Brassica Species. Dr. Komal of Doon University was awarded third prize for the research work in fuzzy lambda Technique.

Rs 50 thousand, Rs 30 thousand and Rs 20 thousand respectively under first, second and third prize along with appreciation certificates are given under the Governor Research Award.

Governor Smt. Maurya announced to add two more awards from next year for the research work in social sciences and local languages.

On the occasion Governor Smt. Maurya said that quality original research work is biggest standard of prestige of any university. Research work and studies should be done in the universities to resolve the various problems and challenges of society. Promoting the original research work and benefiting the society through research work is motive behind these awards, she said. Governor added that Universities should help the government in policy making.
